### **CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health)**

Indexes and abstracts 1,835 allied health journals, publications of the National League for Nursing and the American Nurses Association, nursing dissertations and selected biomedical journals.

Version of CINAHL by Ebscohost, also has thesaurus, limit to research and links out to full text of journals provided by Ebsco publishers

### **Medline**

Biomedical research is indexed and abstracted from 1964 to the present in this database created by the National Library of Medicine. Over 3,900 journals are indexed.

**GALILEO** lists several versions of Medline available, listed under the "Medicine and Health" tab, then Medicine. Ebscohost's version features links to full-text articles from about 100 journals.

### **Evidence Based Medicine (Additional Databases)**

Literature reviews about clinical issues.

### **YourJournals@Ovid (Additional Databases)**

Database containing the full text articles from a group of nursing and psych journal subscriptions.

### **PsycInfo (GALILEO)**

The world's literature in psychology and related disciplines is indexed and abstracted in this database. Its coverage includes journal article published from 1887 to the present!

**Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition (GALILEO, Medicine and Health)**  
provides nearly 520 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines.

**Alt Health Watch (at Ebsco) (GALILEO, Medicine and Health)**  
articles on complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health.

**The Merck Manuals (GALILEO, Medicine and Health)**  
handbooks of basic medical information.

### **Omnifile Full Text (Additional Databases)**

A multi-disciplinary database of articles in periodicals; some articles are available full text.
